## Vice-Chancellor

The highest managerial position of a tertiary institution.

## Dean

An executive who, along with a management team, oversees the daily operations of an academic faculty.

# Registrar

Responsible for student administration and institutional governance of the University.

## Faculty administrator An administrator of a faculty providing support to

students with registration, amending or cancellation of modules, graduation, as well as advice and guidance on faculty-specific matters.
